Competition Results

2010 Asia Beer Award Competition

The Brewers Association Export Development Program members participated in the 2010 inaugural Asia Beer Award international competition, which highlights the variety of beers now available in the region as well as those looking to penetrate the lucrative Asian market.

Traditionally lager and pilsner beers have dominated the Asian beer market, however over the past decade Asian consumers have displayed a greater desire for diversity in their favorite brews. As a reaction to this maturing market, importers have improved the availability of artisan and craft beers from around the world significantly.

Winners of the [2010 Asia Beer Award](#) international competition were recently announced. Brewers Association Export Development Program subscribers took gold, silver, and bronze awards winning a total of 15 awards in 10 different categories. There were 11 EDP members who participated and submitted 37 different beers for the competition and the festival, enabling the US industry to have a good representation. Among those, the following US craft beers were selected as winners:
