TTB Issues Advanced Notice of Rulemaking on Trade Practice Regulations

In response to the President's Executive Order *Promoting Competition in the American Economy* and the subsequent Treasury Department report *Competition in the Markets for Beer, Wine, and Spirits*, the Tax and Trade Bureau (TTB) has published an advance notice of proposed rulemaking in the [Federal Register](#) and is seeking public comment on TTB's trade practice regulations related to the Federal Alcohol Administration Act's exclusive outlet, tied house, commercial bribery, and consignment sales prohibitions.
